## **Jack Simpson Start Lines**

<u>60m</u> Solid white line as shown on the track diagram.

**200m** White/black/white start lines as shown on the track diagram.

**300m** Solid white lines as shown on track diagram.

**800m** If run in lanes (one turn cut-in) the start lines need to be marked with tape. The one turn cut-in needs to be denoted by placing cones at the beginning of the back straight, as there is no permanent break line marked on the track. For younger age classes and other groups if all parties are in agreement, this event starts on the arced start line.

**1,000m to 3,000m** A group start using the white arced start lines in the positions indicated on the track diagram

**4 x 200m Relay** Solid white start line with a three turn cut-in. Exchange zones are open ended. First exchange done in lanes and tape may be utilized. 2<sup>nd</sup> runner runs 1<sup>st</sup> turn in lanes and then may cut in at 800m break line. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> exchanges not done in lanes and tape may not be utilized. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> runners place themselves in the order at the 100 corner and that order can then not be changed. Athletes may however move inside to vacant lanes as long as the order is not changed.

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
