Association Update

Stage 1 of the summer reopening plan starting June 1. This means we can return to training in groups of 10 or less (including coaches) outdoors, masked and distanced, starting **June 1**.

- Distancing and masking requirements remain in effect



Club Nonprofit Governance

- Why do we require Clubs to be/become nonprofits?
 - Fiscal responsibility
 - Credibility
 - Accountability
 - Funding
- Board of Directors
 - Start with the goals and values of the organization and find people who want to achieve those goals and hold those values.
 - Individual capacity; know-how
- Consult a lawyer to review bylaws
- Follow registration steps:

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- Club recommendations:
 - Coaches should be discouraged from being on your club's executive (president, vice, treasurer, secretary) as there will be many decisions that may create a conflict of interest. It's a great idea to have a coach and athlete advisor.
 - Diversify/stagger your board so your directors don't 'age out' with your athletes
 - Keep proper minutes, documentation, and current with Society's Act requirements
 - Keep financial records properly

 - Register all board members as Associates - even if you hold a different role as member
 - Criminal record checks for everyone associated with your club
 - Create communications processes (from Club admin through to coaches/parents/board members)
 - Ensure all people associated with your Club have completed Safe Sport training
