


# Athletics Alberta Officials' Bulletin

## **UPGRADING CRITERIA**

The Athletics Canada National Officials' Committee has revised their upgrading requirements for Levels 1 through 3 as follows:

To summarize

<u>Level 1 pathway</u> Online Clinic - Once completed, a mentor will be assigned. Experience - 4 events – horizontal jumps, throws, track, vertical jumps

<u>Level 2 pathway</u> Online Clinic – mentoring will continue Experience – 2 sessions each – horizontal jumps, throws, track, vertical jumps Evaluation – completed by the mentor.

The minimum time to complete levels 1 and 2 will be one year. Mentor training has started in Alberta.

Level 3 clinic material for each discipline is being gathered and is scheduled to be completed and available by summer 2020. This will be a face to face clinic.

A mentor will be assigned in the chosen discipline for each "new" official and will work with them for a minimum of one year. Also, a practical evaluation will be completed in province.

Level 4 and 5 clinics, mentoring, evaluation and implementation is scheduled for June 2021

To encourage continuous learning, a Maintenance process for levels 3 – 5 is scheduled to be implemented in Fall 2020. Details of this process will be announced later.
